

## PLANTASIA LANDSCAPE AREA RULES FOR 2012



The intent of the Show is to emphasize a Garden and Landscape theme, which is to be reflected in the display. All plants should be kept as clean and neat as possible, using healthy, quality plants. Exhibitors are responsible for keeping their plant material watered or misted to keep the plants in prime condition during the Show. Water features must be lined to prevent leakage and the Exhibitor is responsible for stopping leaks and cleaning up any water in the aisles. A GFI connector must be used. Landscape area layout must not interfere with adjacent landscape or commercial areas. Chemicals and hazardous materials are not to be used. No curtains/drapery in your garden display.

Live or cut plant materials must be used to fulfill the following Requirements:

- 50% of the exhibit floor space must be covered with live plant material.**
- 30% of the total plant material used must contain flowers in bloom.**

*If landscaped area does not meet the criteria above, the Plantasia Committee will inform judges prior to judging and garden may be disqualified from having the garden judged. See enclosed judging criteria.*

**Landscape Area Signage:** Landscapers can use their own signage. Signage must add up to 32 square feet or less – ie, you can have several signs in your garden area but total should add up to 32 square feet. Must be a static sign. This is an opportunity to put your company name and logo as well as the name/logo of companies to be acknowledged.

**Garden Plan:** Landscapers must submit a plan to the Plantasia Committee so that it can be reviewed ahead of time. Plans can be brought to general membership meeting in February or early March (watch your email for dates) or by appointment with Plantasia Chair, Chris Zeisz.

**Plant Acquisition:** The list of plant material is not available at this time. Roger Restorff, CNLP (835-7434) will be coordinating plant material. Please understand that the plant material provided to you through Plant Acquisition is to supplement your plant material – YOU NEED TO HAVE ADDITIONAL PLANT MATERIAL.
